ORDINANCE NO. 2009-08

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW WASTEWATER USER CHARGES FOR THE USE OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL UTILITY SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF LEBANON JUNCTION, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon Junction, Kentucky has constructed a wastewater treatment works and a collection system; and

WHEREAS, it is the City's intent to establish proportionate wastewater user charges that place the costs of abatement directly on the sources of pollution, conserve potable water, and maintain financial self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, the City must pay the OM&R and debt service expenses associated with the said wastewater treatment works and charge the users of said wastewater treatment works accordingly; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lebanon Junction, Kentucky.

SECTION ONE:

Section A: The following schedule of wastewater user charge rates, based on the above-referenced wastewater user charge system data, shall apply to each user of the wastewater treatment works. This schedule includes rates for OM&R and rates for debt service charges, each based on the volume of metered or estimated water consumption.

Section B: For residential, industrial, institutional and commercial users, monthly user charges will be based on actual water usage. If a residential, commercial, institutional, or

industrial user has a consumptive use of water, or, in some other manner, uses water which is not discharged into the wastewater collection system, the user charge for that contributor may be based on readings of a wastewater meter(s) or separate water meter(s) installed and maintained at the user's expense.

SECTION TWO: The billing date and collection penalty for delinquencies charges for the use of the services provided by the municipal utility system to its customers shall be as follows:

The water and sewer rates or charges shall be billed monthly, on statements which shall be issued on or about the first (1st) of each month, and all bills for such service shall be considered due and payable on or before the twentieth (20th) day after the date of issue. If a bill is not paid within twenty (20) days after such date of issue, such bill shall be considered delinquent, and there shall be imposed a penalty on each bill not so paid in the amount of Twenty Seven Dollars (\$27.00). Any water and sewer charges which remain unpaid thirty (30) days after issue shall result in termination of water and sewer service to the customer. The City may, but is not required to, serve a customer written notice of the delinquency and of the fact that such customer is entitled, upon written request, to a hearing on the question of termination of service. If such bill is not paid within thirty (30) days after the issue, and if no hearing is requested, or if a hearing is requested and timely held and such customer's delinquency is thereby established, the City shall disconnect the water service of such customer without further notice. If water service is disconnected by the City by reason of delinquency in the payment of any water and/or sewer bill, reconnection of such service shall not be made until the owner or user pays all charges and penalties owed, plus the amount of Forty Five Dollars (\$45.00) as a disconnection and reconnection charge. If any deadline date falls on a Sunday or legal holiday, such deadline shall not expire until the next secular day thereafter.

SECTION THREE: Water tap-on fees and sewer tap-on fees throughout the City maintained utility system shall be \$1,325.00 each.

<u>SECTION FOUR:</u> Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this ordinance be held invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, or any part of this Ordinance are repealed.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall be published according to law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-<u>11</u>

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE CITY OF LEBANON JUNCTION'S INCREASE CHARGE RATE TO CUSTOMERS OF THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL WATERWORKS SYSTEM BASED UPON RATE INCREASES BY THE LOUISVILLE WATER COMPANY.

WHEREAS the Louisville Water Company has previously and may again raise its charges to the City of Lebanon Junction for water which is then provided through the City's municipal waterworks system to its users, and,

WHEREAS the City of Lebanon Junction has previously passed on such increases to users of the City's municipal waterworks system at the same rate as each increase by the Louisville Water Company, but such increases do not assist the City in meeting other costs incurred providing water to users of the City's municipal waterworks system,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LEBANON JUNCTION, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE: Each charge increase by the Louisville Water Company to the City of Lebanon Junction for water that is then provided to users through the Lebanon Junction municipal waterworks system shall be doubled by the City of Lebanon Junction for its charges to the users of the Lebanon Junction municipal waterworks system.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.

SECTION FOUR: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: Parts of any ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Amending Ordinance No. 2009-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 2009-08 RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW WASTEWATER USER CHARGES FOR THE USE OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL UTILITY SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF LEBANON JUNCTION, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lebanon Junction did adopt Ordinance No. 2009-08 establishing new Wastewater User Charges for the use of services provided by the Municipal Utility System of the City of Lebanon Junction, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, from time to time is becomes necessary to adjust user charges to meet the increased costs of the operations of the City's Municipal Utility System and to ensure the effective and efficient operation of the System; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the best interests of the public to amend the user charges herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON JUNCTION, BULLITT COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE: WATER AND SEWER TAP-ON FEES

Ordinance No. 2009-08, Section Three is amended as follows:

Water tap-on fees and Sewer tap-on fees throughout the City of Lebanon Junction maintained utility system shall be Three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$3,250.00) each.

SECTION TWO: REMAINDER OF ORDINANCE 2009-08 UNAFFECTED

The rest and remainder of Ordinance No. 2009-08 not amended herein shall not be affected by this Ordinance and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. Should any section, subdivision, sentence or clause of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, then such portion shall be deemed a

separate, distinct and independent provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: OTHER ORDINANCES NOT REPEALED

Nothing contained herein shall be construed or deemed to repeal or modify any other Ordinance or portion of any other Ordinance heretofore enacted and in force in the City of Lebanon Junction unless specifically repealed or modified by its explicit terms or by separate Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on Opin 1st, 2020.
